## Checklist - Episodes

This Checklist will help you remember all important steps when preparing, recording, editing and marketing your Podcast episodes.

### 1. TO DO: Pre-Recording

- Research the topic (e.g. News, Google, Wikipedia, Online Forums, TED talks, listen to Podcasts on the topic, watch documentaries)
- (if guest recording): Check guests/organisation's Website
- (if guest recording): Check guests/organisation's social media
- (if guest recording): Check if other interviews with guest/organisation are available
- Write intro for the Podcast
- (if solo show) write script for your Podcast

### 2. TO DO: Recording

- Find a quiet spot
- Turn off all phones and notifications
- Test the microphone and recording levels
- Take a deep breath
- Hit record!
- After recording: don't forget to save your audio file!
- Thank your guest(s) with a kind email note (maybe even informing them when you are planning to air the episode).

### 3. TO DO: Audio Editing

- Cut/edit episode as soon as possible or outsource this task
- Record/add intro (including call to action)
- Record/add outro (including call to action)
- Record/add transitions
- Add music/jingle
- Tag audio file & add episode cover art

### 4. TO DO: Upload Audio File

- Upload audio file to your media server
- Test that the episode is working correctly - quick listen
- If you want to integrate episode on your website: Add episode link in the post for this episode

### 5. TO DO: Marketing

- Create social media artwork (eg with Canva <https://www.canva.com>)
- Schedule release of media art (eg with Planoly <https://www.planoly.com> )
- Draft and schedule a newsletter for promoting the new episode (eg with Mailchimp <https://mailchimp.com>)
